You are aware that it is in the neighbourhood of these islands that cyclones, which are so prevalent in the Bay of Bengal, have their origin. It is thought that, if the Meteorological Department were in telegraphic communication with these islands, they would be able to get more timely and more accurate information of the approach of cyclones, and thus be the means of averting some frightful disaster to shipping. The cost of making the connection is estimated, under the old system of laying cables, at a very large sum, and, while I have no doubt the Government of India...
